
It was built in the 16th century under the direction of the architect Pedro de Alviz, and later restorations were undertaken in the 18th century.

This is a free-standing building with a trapezoidal floor plan and a single nave divided into three bays by columns attached to the wall. The front of the church is designed as if it were a small temple superimposed on the façade..

It has a tower located at the foot of the church.

The current headquarters of the Antonio Pérez Foundation in the capital was once the former Carmelite Convent.

It is a building constructed in 1614, considered to have introduced the first Baroque forms in Castilla.

Its façade stands out, sober and balanced, structured by a symmetrical axis that runs along the façade, the window of the choir loft, the oculus and the cross.

Inside there are several rooms spread over four floors and a simple inner courtyard typical of Cuenca's noble houses.

The Casa del Curato is an example of popular medieval architecture, built in the 15th century, and located in the upper part of the city of Cuenca, in the old district of Saint Martin. The interior conserves two masonry walls with a Gothic arcade.

The building currently houses the Provincial Archaeological Museum of Cuenca, created in 1963 to house the collections from the Roman city of Valeria.

Archaeological excavations documented part of the former palace of the Carrillo family, a prominent 16th-century building.

The Museum is located in the historic centre of Cuenca, accessible through the pedestrian streets. It has a centre for scientific dissemination, a planetarium, a temporary exhibition hall and two meeting rooms, equipped with projectors, a sound system and their own Wi-Fi network.





The Parador, with its spectacular location, is situated in the middle of the Huecar gorge, in front of the Casas Colgadas, whose access, like that of the old town, is the singular bridge of Saint Paul. The Parador is built on the site of the former Convent of San Pablo (16th century).

The glazed cloister and its old chapel, now converted into a friendly cafeteria, complement an interior that combines traditional elements with the most contemporary details. It has 63 cosy rooms, some with magnificent views, and all of them perfectly equipped.


